Song of 9 Needles to Return the Yang

- Used when there's <u>extreme</u> deficiency of Yang
 - Indications:
 - Trouble breathing
 - Incontinance (both ends)
 - Chills
 - Cold limbs
 - Oily sweat
 - Labored breathing
 - SHOCK
- These are all Cold signs

1) Loss of Yang Rooted in Kidneys

Ki 1, Ki 3

- Ki 1 anchors pathological Liver Yang, pulling it down
- Ki 1 anchors pathological Heart Yang that's blazing up (causing anxiety, insomnia, &tc.)
- Ki 1 clears up sore throat
- Ki 1 also deals with Marrow issues
 - Brittle bones
 - Loss of memory
- Ki 3 does the same as Ki 1, but its action is milder

2) Loss of Yang from Dampness and/or Cold

Sp 6, St 36, Ren 12

- Sp 6 is the meeting point of the three Yin Leg meridians
- Sp 6 treats emotional, urinary and gynocological problems
 - When Spleen does not transform food into Gu Qi and ascend it to the Lungs, Dampness accumulates in belly
 - Spleen Deficiency also causes prolapse of organs
- St 36 is one of the 11 Heavenly Star Points
- St 36 can be used to treat all diseases
- St 36 harmonizes Stomach
 - Helps with nausea and vomiting
 - Helps with aches
 - Gets rid of food stagnation
 - Helps with Full Stomach Heat (hungry all the time)
 - Helps with Empty Stomach Heat (patient often feels like they're hungy, but they don't eat)
- St 36 is the Command point of the abdomen
- Ren 12 is the Mu Point of the Stomach

3) Loss of Yang from Exuberant Heat with Wind

Du 15, LI 4

- Du 15 is used for people who can't talk due to Wind stroke
- LI 4 is the Command point of the face and mouth
- LI 4 is a Heavenly Star Point
- LI 4 can be used for:
 - Nose bleeds
 - Tooth aches
 - Facial swelling
 - Expelling Wind

4) Loss of Yang from Heart

P 6

- P 6 helps with all Heart problems

5) <u>Loss of Yang due to Bi-Obstruction in the Limbs</u> GB 30

- Opens all Jing-well points on legs and pushes out pathogens
 - Needle with large 3" needle
